- Hands-on learning activity in the Tuskegee Airmen Alcove utilizing real flight computers;
- Explore the new <u>Lost Man Blues</u>: <u>Jon Schueler Art and War exhibition</u> with a handson navigation activity. Guests can track Schueler's (a World War II B-17 bomber flight navigator) flight path during a January 1943 bombing run to St. Nazaire using navigation instruments of the day.
