

## THE VIETNAM TAP CODE

Developed by four American POWs who were imprisoned in North Vietnam beginning in 1965, the 5x5 grid system is separated by rows and columns. The letter C is used for both C and K. The first series of taps indicates the row number, the second series of taps indicates the column. The letter X was used as the period or to separate sentences.
