COLUMBUS, Ohio – On Friday, November 11 at 11 a.m., the <u>National Veterans Memorial and Museum</u> (NVMM) will present its annual <u>Veterans Day Ceremony</u> in the Great Hall. The military ceremony honors and celebrates the service and sacrifice of all Veterans and active-duty service members while remembering those who are no longer here.

In collaboration with VetsAid organizers, special guest speakers during the Veterans Day Ceremony include:
