in order to receive the discounted group rate.

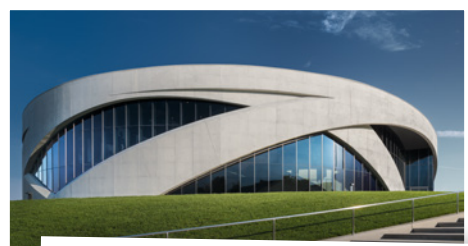
